Dear colleagues:

The International Conference on Recent Advances in Neurotraumatology ICRAN 2016, will be held in Bogota, on December 8 to 11 of 2016.

This academic meeting is an official international event of the World Federation of Neurosurgical Societies (WFNS) together with the Colombian Association of Neurosurgery (ACNQx) and allows a comprehensive assessment of the most important issues in the world of neurotrauma neurosurgery, including aspects of emergency care, neurological surgical and neuro-critical care, including emerging trends in neuro-rehabilitation. We will discuss topics related to systemic injuries, blunt and penetrating injuries of the head, blunt and penetrating injuries of the spine, vascular injuries, new trends in resuscitation, hemorrhage control and neuro-protection, organization of integral care for neurotrauma, policy development for centers of excellence in emergency neurosurgery and advances in neuro-rehabilitation.

In addition, into this event, it will be held an International Symposium of the Global Initiative for Emergency and Essential Surgical Care (GIEESC). This initiative is part of a new trend in Global Surgery, including Neurosurgery, promoted by the World Health Organization in order to provide better surgical care for populations in low and middle-income countries.

This event has been endorsed by academic international stakeholders in this topic and will be a great opportunity to improve the quality of care for patients with neurotrauma and neurosurgical emergencies in the Latin American and Caribbean region.

Several pre-conference activities will take place, including:
